This qualification is achieved by 'successfully completing' all the nominated core and elective units. This can be achieved by participating in training sessions, completing assignments and by demonstrating your ability by putting the learning into practice under real road conditions.

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The entry requirements for this program are

Individuals must have at least 12 months experience in a rural industry. Applicants must demonstrate the language, literacy and numeracy required at least level 3. An LL&N assessment is conducted at pre-enrolment to assess if you require support in this regard.

The competency assessment will be

Demonstration of knowledge through written/oral answers, online assessments and projects

Demonstration of driving and workplace skills through practical assessment based on legislative and regulatory requirements and industry standards.

Delivery Mode

Training will consist of face-to-face and online training. Practical training will be given in a simulated or workplace setting by a qualified trainer and assessor.

Duration

Up to 12 months

Cost
